Associate Professor Kynan Feeney is an Adjunct Associate Professor at ECU's Exercise Medicine Research Institute, with expertise in medical oncology.

**Associate Professor Kynan Feeney** graduated from UWA with honours in 1998. After completing his residency at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital he went on to do advanced training in Public Health Medicine, publishing research based on field work in WA and overseas. He completed his Masters of Public Health and returned to complete training in Medical Oncology at SCGH, RPH and Fremantle Hospitals. He is currently working full-time at St John of God Hospital Murdoch, where he is a member of the Medical Advisory Committee and Chair of the Oncology Craft Group, overseeing cancer services for the hospital. Dr Feeney is a highly active member of the clinical trials unit, where he is the principal investigator for clinical trials spanning breast, melanoma, colorectal, prostate, kidney, gastric and pancreas cancers. He also has a strong interest in teaching, serving as mentor for final year Medical Students from Notre Dame University as an adjunct Associate Professor of Medicine. Dr Feeney is also a key clinical collaborator in many research trials requiring medical oncologist through-put as an adjunct Associate Professor at the Exercise Medicine Research Institute (Edith Cowan University).
